What is PKD?

- Polycystic kidney disease (PKD) is **one of the most common, life-threatening genetic kidney diseases** affecting thousands in America and millions worldwide. People with PKD develop fluid-filled cysts in their kidneys which cause them to increase in size and decrease in function. Kidneys can grow to be as large as footballs and weigh up to 30 pounds.
- PKD is the fourth leading cause of kidney failure and **there is no treatment or cure.** When kidneys no longer function, dialysis and kidney transplantation are the only options.
- Because PKD is a genetic disease, entire families are directly affected. Parents have a 50 percent chance of passing it to each of their children, impacting future generations.
- A relatively rare form of PKD called autosomal recessive polycystic disease (ARPKD) affects approximately 1 in 20,000 children and often causes mortality in the first month of life. For those that survive the newborn period, approximately one-third will need dialysis or a transplant by age 10.

PKD Foundation

The PKD Foundation has been leading the fight against PKD for more than 30 years through **research**, **education**, **advocacy**, **support and awareness**. The Foundation is the only organization in the U.S. dedicated solely to finding treatments and a cure for this disease.
